Open Call for LIAISE COST Action YRI Conference Grants

3rd Grant Period

Introduction

One of the main COST Action CA22110 LIAISE objectives is to support Young Researchers and Innovators (YRIs) in their professional development and networking opportunities. YRI Conference Grants are limited exclusively to Young Researchers and Innovators for the presentation (oral or poster) of their own work at high-level conferences fully organized by a third party (i.e., not organized nor co-organized by the COST Action).

The YRI Conference Grant:

- Serves COST Excellence and Inclusiveness Policy;
- Supports Young Researchers and Innovators to establish a strong network and increase their visibility in the research community through sharing their work and gaining knowledge;
- Contributes to increasing the visibility of the Action.

The YRI Conference Grantee receives support for attending and presenting their own work within the scope of the Action at a conference and can establish new contacts for future collaborations. This is a contribution for traveling, accommodation and subsistence expenses, registration fee, printing of scientific posters and overall effort.

Cut-off Dates and Budget

- 15th December 2025
- 15th February 2026
- 15th April 2026
- 15th June 2026

After 15th June 2026, if there is a budget available, the applications will be processed as they are received. In the same vein, if the budget runs out of any of the previous cut-offs, participants will be informed, and the following calls will not be carried out.

All the applications that have been sent by the cut-off date will be evaluated within 15 days and the applicants will be informed about the decision. Up to 2500 EUR can be awarded for face-to-face conferences and up to 500 EUR for virtual conferences.

Only applications for future events will be approved. Grants cannot be awarded retroactively for conferences that have already taken place at the time of the cut-off date.

All YRI Conference Grants need to be finished, and their report submitted maximum on the last day of the grant period (31/10/2026).

Eligibility criteria

YRI Conference Grants are reserved for Young Researchers and Innovators (typically <40 years old)

Applicants must:

- Have an accepted paper at a conference and present it as an oral or poster presentation.
- Be listed in the official conference programme.
- Ensure that the presentation is on the topic of the Action LIAISE and acknowledges COST (see How to acknowledge COST funding).
- Respect that the conference, the submission of expenses, and the reporting must take place before the end of the current Grant Period.

Additional information

- Priority will be given to active Working Group members whose application is endorsed by the Working Group.
- The submission for YRI Conference Grants must be after the acceptance of the paper.
- Attendance at European conferences is preferred. However, conferences held elsewhere can also be considered.
- Applicants to YRI Conference Grants shall not apply to different types of conference grants in the same period.

Evaluation criteria

All the applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- 65% The quality and relevance of the publication/presentation.
- 25% The conference rankings.
- 10% Diversity.

How to apply?

To apply for a YRI Conference Grant, please fill in the [online application](#) on the e-cost system and attach the required documents.

- Filled application form (can be downloaded from the e-cost system). Note that the applications without clear contribution to the Action objectives will not be taken into consideration. Priority will be given to applications that are coordinated with the working groups.
- The Applicant's CV, including recent publications (max. 1 page).
- The acceptance letter of the conference Organizers or invitation from the Organizers (for a keynote presentation etc.)
- Copy of the accepted conference abstract or oral presentation.

Your application will be first evaluated by the Grant Awarding team (composed by the Grant Awarding leader, the Grant Awarding co-leader and the Action Chair). Then, if the remaining budget allows to provide funding it will be submitted for approval by the MC Chair of the Action. It is expected that each YRI grantee will send a copy of their presentation including LIAISE and COST Action logos and a short summary of their participation at the conference to the YRI Conference Grants Manager of the LIAISE Action for dissemination. The material must be submitted to the YRI Conference Grants Manager by email shortly after the conference. Photographic material from the conference (e.g., the Applicant with the LIAISE logo in background) will also be requested.
